If you find yourself the victim of fraud, cybercrime, or identity theft, call these organizations for help:



- Financial Institutions, Retailers, and Telephone/Utility Service Providers**
 - To check for and resolve fraudulent transactions

 - To flag your file with a fraud alert and request a free copy of your credit report

 - If you suspect your social security number has been misused
- Your State Department of Motor Vehicles**
 - If you suspect a driver's license has been established in your name

 - If you suspect a passport has been created in your name
- Internal Revenue Service 1 (877) 777-4778**
 - If tax fraud has been committed in your name
- Your State Consumer Protection Offices**
 - To obtain additional resources to help you contact creditors and dispute errors
- Your Local Postal Inspector**
 - If you suspect that an identity thief has submitted a change-of-address form to redirect your mail
